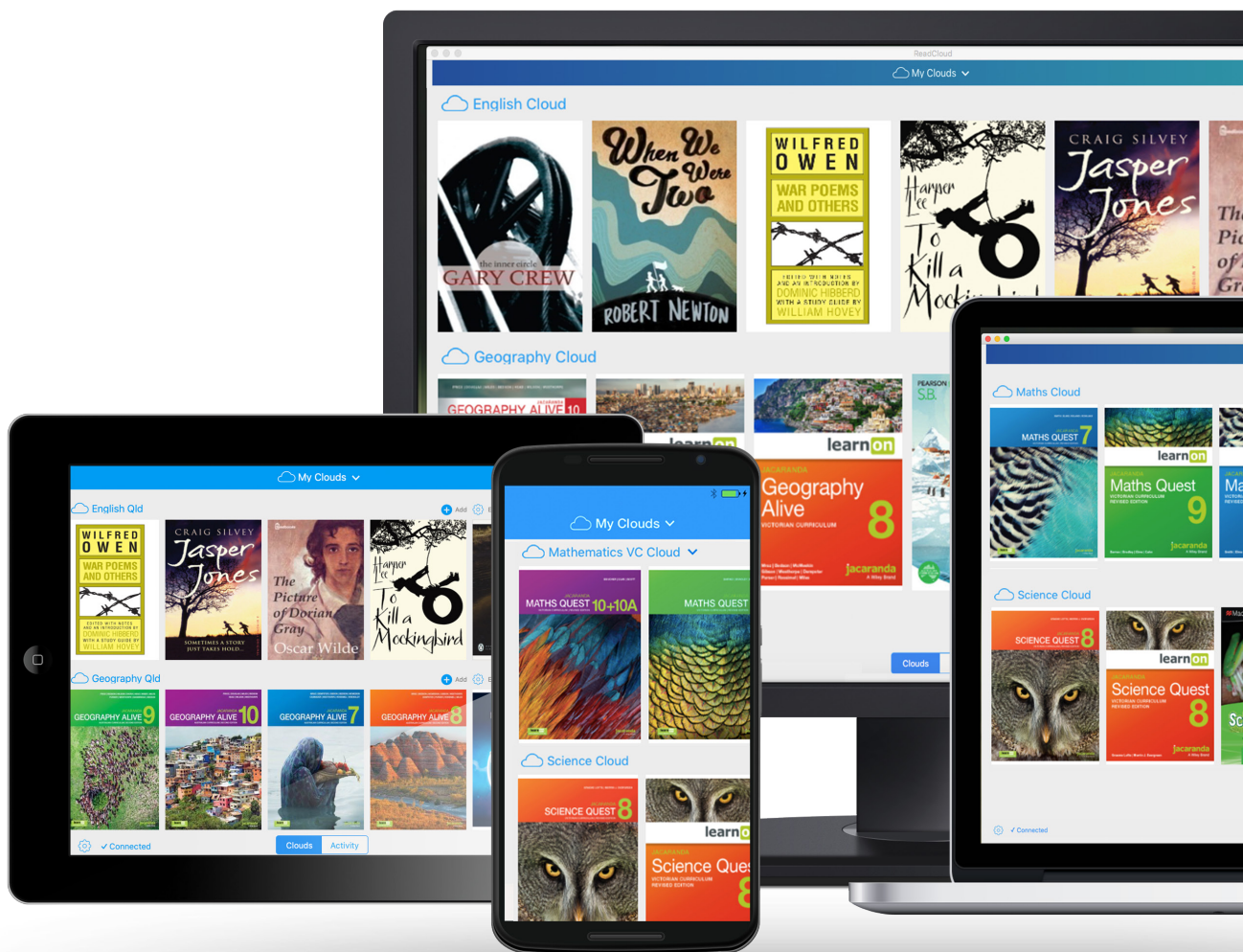

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# Introduction

The following guide details installation and use of the ReadCloud's integration with Moodle.

## **ReadCloud Integration for Moodle.**

The ReadCloud Learning Tool Integration (LTI) enables students and teachers to view their ReadCloud content library directly within Moodle, without additional logins.

It also provides a simple mechanism to embed links to ReadCloud content directly within a course. Clicking either of these items will seamlessly open that content within the ReadCloud native app or web app.

# Before you begin

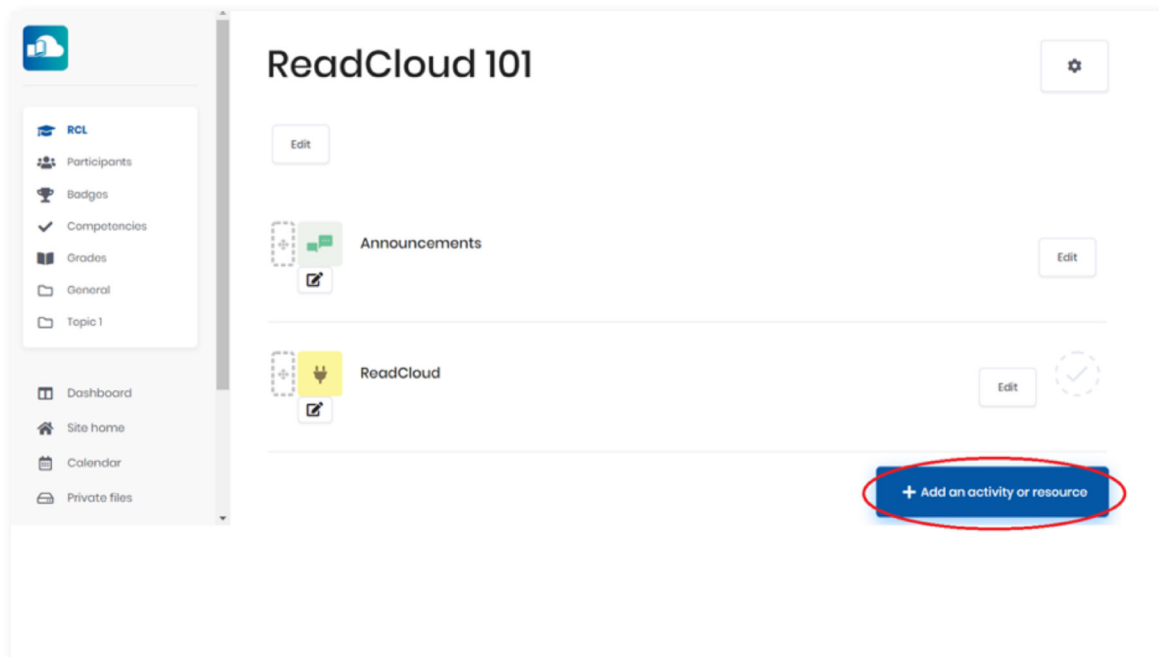
## To install ReadCloud within Moodle you will need:

- A login to Moodle with Editor access (i.e. a teacher or administrator role)
- A ReadCloud LTI Consumer Key
- A ReadCloud LTI Consumer Secret

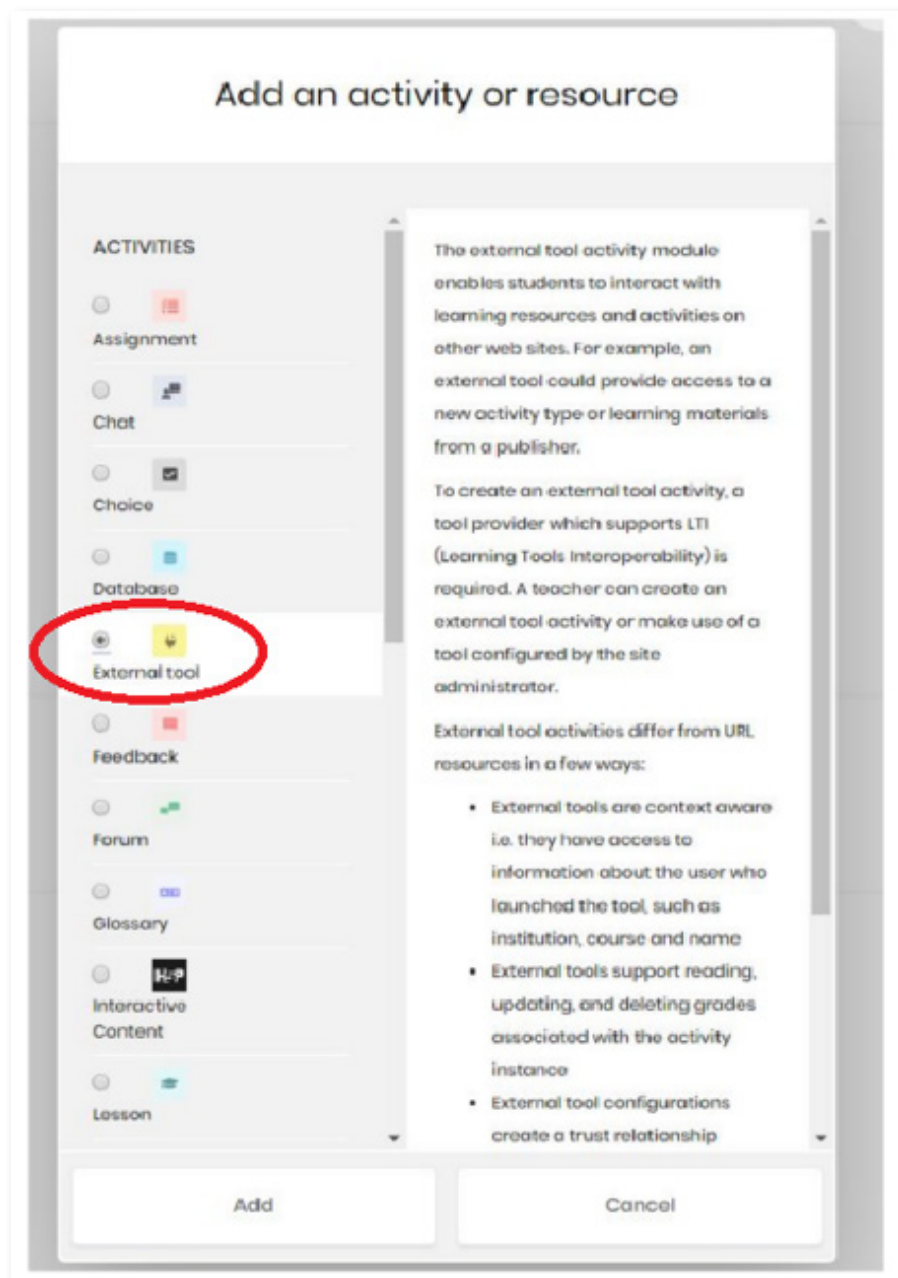

# Installation Steps


1. Log into Moodle, and navigate to the course you wish to add ReadCloud to.
2. Ensure course editing is turned on, and select ['Add an activity or resource'](#)



3. From the dialogue box that appears, select 'External Tool' and click Add.



4. You will now be presented with the External Tool options screen.



## Complete the following fields

### Activity Name:

A description of the ReadCloud tool that is visible to students and teachers. For example: 'Your ReadCloud content library'

### Preconfigured Tool:

Set to 'Automatic, based on tool URL'

### Tool URL:

Set to 'https://apiv2.readcloud.com/lti'

### Note:

You may need to click 'Show More..' to see the following settings.

### Secure Tool URL:

Set to 'https://apiv2.readcloud.com/lti'

### Launch Container:

Choose one of the following options:

- **Embed:** the ReadCloud content library will be contained within the course content.
- **Embed, without blocks:** the ReadCloud content library will be contained within the course content, however no other course content will be displayed while open.
- **Existing Window:** the ReadCloud content library will load in the current browser window, replacing Moodle
- **New Window:** the ReadCloud content library will open in a new tab / browser window.

We recommend choosing 'New Window' to provide the best reading experience.

### Consumer Key:

Your LTI Consumer Key provided by ReadCloud.

### Consumer Secret:

Your LTI Consumer Secret provided by ReadCloud.

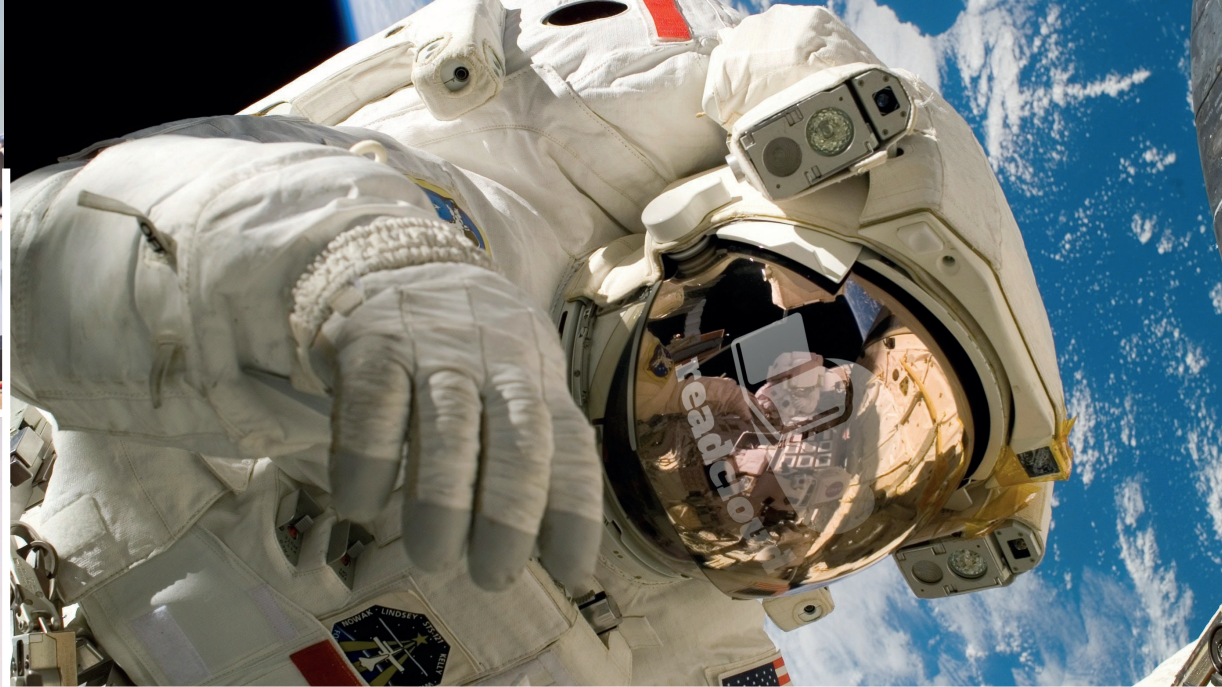
### Icon URL:

(Optional) Set this to an image you would like displayed next to the tool URL.

5. Click 'Save & Display'.

ReadCloud is now successfully embedded into Moodle. Students and teachers can now access the ReadCloud content library and all its features from within their Moodle through one easy log in.
